

ORDINANCE NO. 757

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AT A SPECIFIED LOCATION ON THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND APPROVING THE CLOSURE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY FOR THE SOLOMON FESTIVAL STREET DANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade the intersection of Poplar Street and Main Street, extending into a portion of the 200 Block of West Main Street, between the hours of 8:00 p.m. on July 15, 2023, and 1:00 a.m. on July 16, 2023, for the Solomon Festival Street Dance (the “Event”).

Section 2. The barricaded portion of Poplar Street and Main Street, as set forth above shall be temporarily closed between the hours of 8:00 p.m. on July 15, 2023, and 1:00 a.m. on July 16, 2023. Event attendees twenty-one (21) and older may possess and consume alcoholic beverages in the specified areas and during the times designated above. No person under the age of eighteen (18) shall be allowed in the barricaded area where alcoholic liquor is being consumed.

Section 3. City Code 3-106 pertaining to open containers in public shall be waived in the specified areas and during the times designated above. No alcoholic liquor will be consumed or sold outside the confined dance area except in taverns not included in the defined area, which are licensed for such sales.

Section 4. The Event is hereby approved by the Governing Body as required by K.S.A. 41-719(a)(3).

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:

Ordinance No. 757 Summary

On July 10, 2023, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 757. The ordinance authorizes the consumption, and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location on the public right-of-way, generally described as the intersection of Main Street and Poplar Street, and approves the closure of public property for the Solomon Festival Street Dance.
