

ORDINANCE NO. 767

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, SECTION 15-221 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS PERTAINING TO RATES FOR WATER FURNISHED BY THE CITY TO PREMISES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; AND REPEALING EXISTING SECTION 15-221.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 15-221 of the City Code of the City of Solomon, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-221. Rates.

The following rates are hereby established for water furnished by the City to premises within the city limits and those approved by the council outside the city limits:

- (a) Minimum, up to 1,000 gallons: \$21.50
- (b) All in excess of 1,000 gallons: \$3.84 per 1,000 gallons
- (c) Bulk Water shall be sold at the rate of:
 - (1) \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons
 - (2) A \$25.00 connection fee shall be charged on each purchase.
- (d) The customer is responsible for any damages to portable meter or hydrants and shall reimburse the city for repair or replacement of equipment or facilities which are damaged.


SECTION TWO. Existing Section 15-221 is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:
